Ngunnawal Primary School has a breakfast club that is staffed by volunteers from local churches. We are looking for people to give a hand on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

#### **Oasis**

At a recent gathering with some families form GUC we raised the issue that we were not able to, nor did we want to continue coordinating Oasis in the way we have for the last year. We have been short of volunteers and people with the passion for the ministry it provides.

For the time being we discussed that we would run Oasis on 1st and 3rd Sundays, and that during 2020 we will focus on practices of faith. On the 1st Sundays we will run a program exploring different christian practices (prayer, fasting, communion...) and on 3rd Sundays we would run a kids church space in the multi-purpose room with scripture, story, song and practices.

**1st Sunday** - Oasis, a focus on christian practices, initially spending some weeks on prayer (thank you, help, sorry, awe and wonder (praise)

2nd Sunday - All Age Worship & Communion

**3rd Sunday** - Oasis will meet for a kids church with Darren and Oasis Coordinator, we will provide a space for song, prayer, story and open response time where children can engage with a theme in a way that is natural to them.

**4th Sunday** - All Age Worship (would it be possible to run a creche on the fourth Sunday for young people too young for Oasis)

5th Sunday - All Age Worship

# **Medical & Emergency Information**

We are in the process of moving our medical and emergency information for young people under 18 at GUC to the same system the Boys and Girls Brigades currently use. CareMonkey (<a href="https://www.caremonkey.com">https://www.caremonkey.com</a>) is an online system to assist groups in looking after the young people in their care. It will allow us to have access to medical information and seek permission and consent for other events that we may hold as a part of our ministry with young people.
