## equipping you for a lifetime of good practice and learning in planting and sustaining fresh expressions of church

What does it look like when we build Christian discipleship communities shaped by people who aren't yet members of any church?

How do we establish missional communities where people can encounter and live out the Gospel of Jesus Christ without having to step into a church building?

In September 2019, *Mission Shaped Ministry*, a program originally created in the UK as part of the *Fresh Expressions* movement, will come to the Canberra Region Presbytery. The Mission Shaped Ministry courses are being delivered by Canberra Region Presbytery in association with teams from *Uniting Mission and Education* (UME) and *Uniting*.
