Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for the children and families who are involved in our church and for the leaders of Playgroup, Oasis, Billabong, Boys and Girls Brigades. We give thanks for their part and the encouragement they bring.
- This week we join with the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for Crookwell Parish.
 We pray for the joint Advent activities with GRACE and Goulburn; for the ongoing work on the childcare project; and for those in our community feeling isolated.
- This week we join with the World Council of Churches in praying for Brunei, Malaysia, Singapore.
