I understand The Uniting Church's volunteer insurance policy does not cover a volunteer's private or a third party's vehicle or any associated personal injury claims should there be an accident while undertaking volunteer duties. I understand this means I will not be compensated by the Uniting Church (including Gungahlin Uniting Church) for any costs incurred by not being comprehensively insured.
8. I will not be alone with a child in a car. If circumstances make this unavoidable, I will immediately declare the situation to the Volunteer Contact Person.

STATUTORY DECLARATION  
*Statutory Declarations Act 1959*

*Note 1* A person who intentionally makes a false statement in a statutory declaration is guilty of an offence, the punishment for which is imprisonment for a term of 4 years — see section 11 of the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959*.

*Note 2* Chapter 2 of the *Criminal Code* applies to all offences against the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959* — see section 5A of the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959*.

**A statutory declaration under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959* may be made before—**

(1) a person who is currently licensed or registered under a law to practise in one of the following occupations:
