Congratulations to Carrie Warren on receiving The Girls' Brigade Queen's Award. Presented by Her Excellency Linda Hurley at Government House on Friday 23 February, The Queen's Award (which going forward will be known as The International Award) is the highest award to be obtained in The Girls' Brigade internationally. It is designed to encourage girls and young women to a personal commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ, while respecting other faiths; inspiring them to greater endeavour in service within the general community and to make a contribution to the worldwide concept of The Girls' Brigade.

We currently over 20 girls in our group from Kinder to Year 10, most of whom attend other churches or don't attend church at all.
