Church Council Update

Church council met on Monday 14th April to discuss the life and works of GUC. The main points we wish to share with you include;

- Our Emergency Evacuation Procedures, including signage and next steps to identify fire wardens are in progress
- The Property Team are working to fix the water tanks that were vandalised
- Rob, our treasurer will provide a quarterly update to the congregation on giving as well as head a fundraising committee as part of our commitment to fund a *Family and Community* Coordinator, in conjunction with the Synod Growth Fund Grant over the next five years.

- On Sunday 25th May at 4:30pm, a meet and greet afternoon tea for new members to GUC has been scheduled. Keep an eye out for more information in upcoming *Bulletins*.
- Church Council approved a draft policy for *Disability Inclusion* which will be presented to the congregation for consultation.
 - As part of this policy we will be seeking out individuals to consult on ways to create a more inclusive community. It was discussed that the Property Team will be consulted on updating signage for our *Hearing Loop* area within the church, and research into an accessibility ramp for our stage.
 - We would like to identify any ways to ensure our neurodiverse members or those with hidden disabilities are able to feel welcomed, valued, and able to participate at GUC.
