

Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!


- This week we pray for our worship over Easter and for all who visit from the community, from families, from other church congregations.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for Goulburn Uniting Church We pray for God's guidance as we seek a new minister; for continued strength and commitment from our ageing congregation; and that God will work in the hearts of those we meet through our outreach programs such as café, op shop and Girls' Brigade.

We pray for a continual healing of historic memories and pains that have been mutually inflicted; for those who continue to experience marginalization and injustice, especially the Roma; and for religion to be a means of healing rather than of further separation.

Funding for a Family and Young People Ministry Facilitator

Our expression of interest (EOI) for a Synod Growth Fund grant to fund a position to coordinate and facilitate our family and young people ministry has been approved and lodged by Presbytery. This is the first stage of applying for a grant. We will hear in mid-May whether we have been successful in being invited to lodge an application for a grant (second stage of the process).

The total cost of the position is expected to be around \$649,000 over 5 years. The EOI seeks a grant of over \$455,400, with GUC contributing around \$193,500 over the 5 years. GUC funding will come from a mixture of growth in congregational giving, savings and fund-raising initiatives.
