## Our Church at Prayer...

Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for families in our congregation and for our young adults and children who find themselves in times of struggle in a complex world, and who feel it hard to find peace within themselves.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for Monaro Parish (Cooma and Bombala). We give thanks for the faithful service of congregation members of Cooma who lead in worship. We give thanks for the partnership that is being fostered between Wesley Forrest Uniting Church and Cooma Uniting Church. We pray for the surrounding community of Cooma, especially as the snow season approaches.
- This week we join with the World Council of Churches in praying for India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka. We give thanks for the diversity of peoples in these countries: their cultures, values and spirituality. We pray for those who struggle to overcome grinding poverty; for Christians and others who selflessly work in the community, their efforts at ensuring the rights of all citizens, and their collaborative work; and for leaders to keep priority on the wellbeing of the people and the earth itself amid demands for economic growth.
