Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for family life. For parents. For children. For grandparents. For husbands, wives and partners.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for North Belconnen. Pray for the Presbytery Creative Workshop and Service on 21st June designed for young people and families: that relationships can be strengthened and steps towards discipleship will evolve. Pray for the ministry of Rev Andrew Jago, the Church Council, and the Pastoral Care Committee as we address the range of needs and challenges related to an aging congregation.
