LIDS4KIDS Collection Bin

Did you know that plastic lids smaller than a credit card can't go into our home recycling bins? That means they go to landfill and can take hundreds to thousands of years to break down, and even then can leave microplastics that continue to pollute the environment.

BUT we now have a collection bin in our foyer for you to recycle your plastic lids from **water**, **soft drink & milk bottles**! All you need to do is make sure they are:

- * washed and dry
- * single coloured, no pop tops/ hinges
- * bigger than a 10c coin
- * smaller than a credit card

Billabong will sort them into colours and arrange for them to be delivered to LIDS4KIDS for recycling.
