Church Council Update

Church council met this past week. Key points to share are:

- The approval of two new groups:
 - The *Friendship group* will be open for those wanting to meet and do crafting over a cup of tea. Proposed to meet fortnightly on a Wednesday morning
 - A group for those in College (grade 11+) and University ages (approx up to 26yrs) who want to meet to discuss faith journey questions and real life ideas in a conversational / mentor type format. This group is still in a planning stage so all details are still being discussed.
- Church council approves the list of 2026 Volunteers (subject to completion of all safe church requirements). There are several volunteers whose safe church training is up for renewal this year.
- There have been two members of the congregation who have been approached and accepted to join church council to build our numbers. Both Margaret Reeson and John McKenzie have accepted to join as members for 2026, and have been voted in by the council during this meeting. This brings our council to 10 plus the Minister Hugh.
